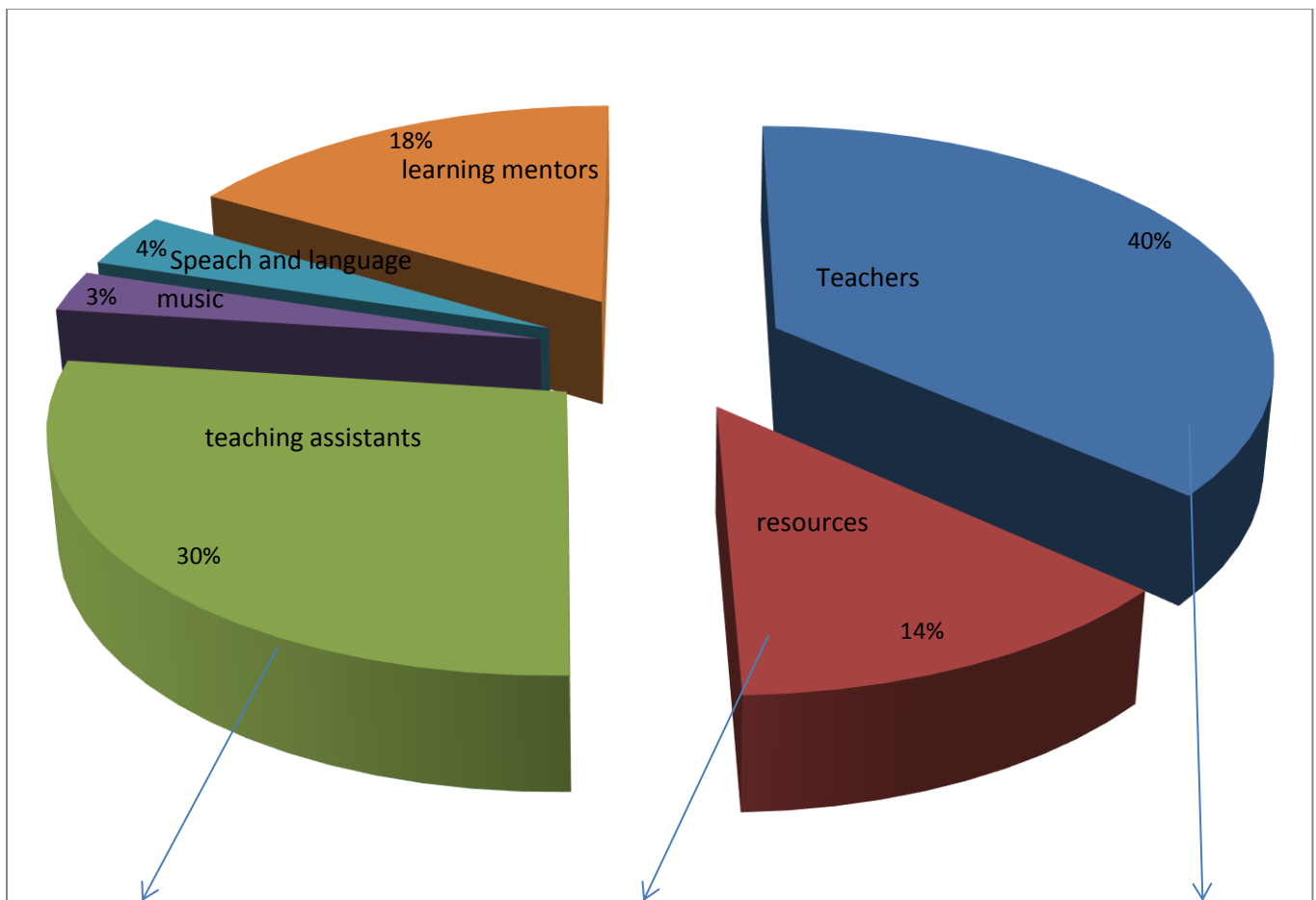


## Pupil Premium Spending 2015-16

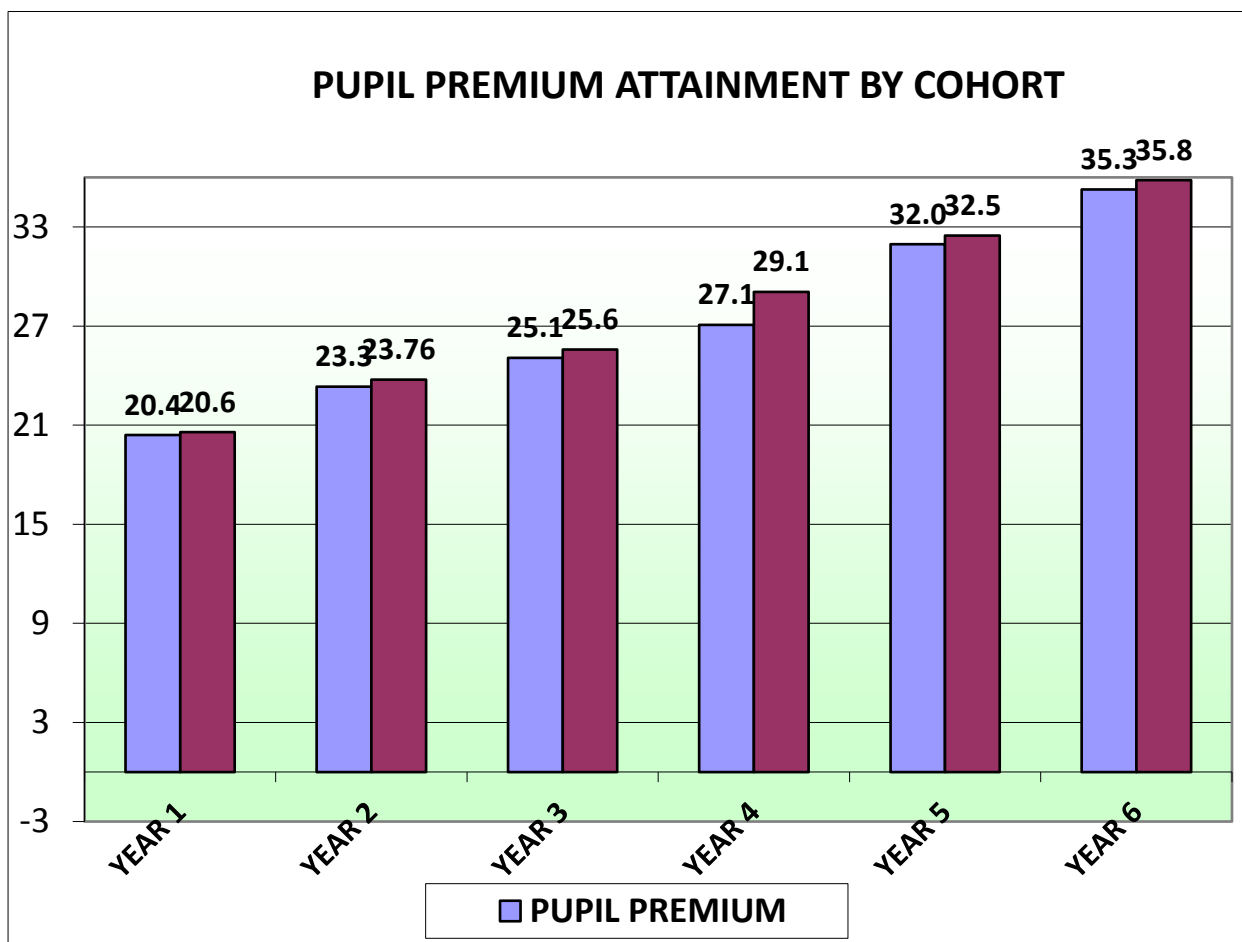
