There is also a summer reading challenge so please try to take part in this over the summer holidays. You will need to click on the link and log in to record the books you have read.

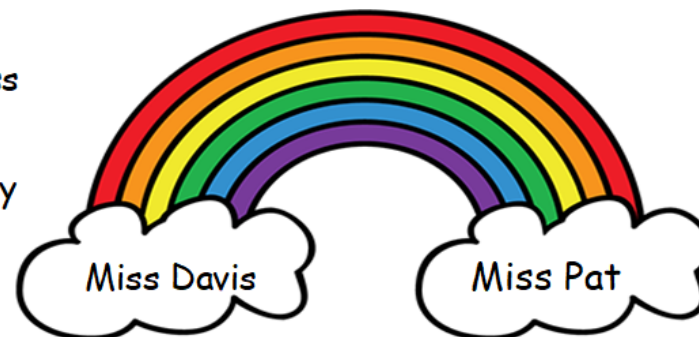
