This will then lead you onto subjects. The subjects which are relevant for your child's current learning are:

English – work through the '**How Coyote Brought Fire to the Earth unit.**' (there are 10 sessions)

Maths – work through '**Numbers within 100**' (there are 10 sessions)

History – work through "**Why do we celebrate Bonfire Night**" (there are 3 sessions)

Science – work through '**Changing Materials**' (there are 6 sessions)

On the 'Busy Things' website click on ages 6-7. Activities for you to do with your child are

English – '**comprehension**' (work through the comprehension activities available)

English - '**vocabulary, grammar and punctuation**' (work through the activities available in this section)

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English – **'transcription'** – work through the activities

Maths – **'number and place value'** – work through the activities

Art – **'make a masterpiece'** – work through the activities

Computing – **'early coding'** – work through the activities.

We will be providing food bags whilst your child is self-isolating and we will be in touch about when you can come and collect the food bag. Please note that the government voucher scheme has now finished.
