Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Government funding for food during the Christmas school closure period.

With the Christmas holidays getting closer and the impact of the pandemic and 2nd lockdown leading to more and more families facing hardship, we are trying to make sure that the school holds the most up to date Free School Meals information.

You may be eligible to free school meals if you are in receipt of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (**provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190**)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income **must be less than £7,400 a year** (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Every child entitled to Free School Meals (through the criteria above), can benefit from the government funding for food during the Christmas school closure period.

If your child is not registered for Free School Meals and you have become recently entitled to any of the benefits above, we are encouraging parents/carers to complete and return the attached form to the school office by **Friday 4th December 2020**. Your application will be processed in confidence by the local authority.

Please contact the school office if your circumstances change in the future to ensure our system remains up to date.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are asking parents/carers whose children attend a Southwark school to complete this form if you believe you have a statutory entitlement to Free School Meals. For anyone applying after 1st April for free school meals the parent/carer will have to complete this form once as the claim will expire on in March 2022 due to the rollout of Universal Credit.

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,345 for your child's primary school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities. Please contact the school for this information or look at your school newsletter from your child's school.

Please return your application directly to your child's school which will then be processed in confidence by the local authority.

Criteria for eligibility for Free School meals

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.
