Dear Parents/Carers,

We are absolutely delighted that all children will be returning to school on Monday 8th March and we look forward to seeing you then. Below is information about the re-opening of the school.

Covid-19 symptoms

If your child or any household member has symptoms of covid-19 (a high temperature, a continuous cough, a loss of taste or smell), please do not send your child to school. Instead you will need to self-isolate and book a covid-19 test.

Start and finish times

Below are the start and finish times for each class. I would also like to remind you that we ask that only one person drops off and collects their child from the gates and that parents do not gather together when dropping off and collecting their child. It is really important that social distancing rules are maintained.

The location of where the children are dropped off and collected have not changed, nor have the start times.

Siblings should attend from the start time of the earliest sibling and join breakfast club.

Breakfast club and after school club

Breakfast club and after school club will start once more from Monday 8th March and will need to be pre-booked. Please contact the office if you require places.

Laptops

Uniform

Water bottles

Please provide your child with a labelled water bottle which they can fill up during the day

Reading books

If you have any school reading books at home, please return on the first day back. We will be sending reading books home once more, but these will be on specific days in order to ensure books can be quarantined before being re-issued.

Safety measures

Following DFE guidelines, we have stringent safety measure in place which include

- Children in class bubbles which are separate from the other class bubbles
- Regular handwashing
- One way systems
- Staggered starts/breaks and finish times
- Zoned areas for eating lunch
- Adults socially distanced from each other
- Enhanced cleaning
- Twice weekly testing available to staff
- Staff to wear face coverings in communal areas

Adults entering the school

If you need to enter the reception area, we ask that you wear a face covering (unless you are medically exempt.)

If you need to speak to a member of staff, we ask that you initially arrange a telephone consultation. If you need to have a face to face meeting with a member of staff inside the school building, we ask that you wear a face covering.
